Objective: The wooded, lodge-like setting of The Lindner Center of HOPE in Mason, OH, offers a "warm and welcoming embrace" to all who visit. The Center offers state-of-the-science diagnostic and treatment services for people suffering from mental illness, integrated with primary medical care and clinical research. For those suffering from mental illness, their families, and loved ones, the Center brings hope, leadership, and treatment innovation.
