Objective:

The support staff for the Hamilton Branch of The Lane Public Library was eager to move out of cramped quarters into newly constructed space. The 24,000 square foot location would house nearly 40 people in administration, public relations, and bookmobile departments - bringing them all into one functional space compared to the existing disjointed and multi-location set-up.
