Objective:

A new 74,000 square foot building was constructed to house 300 students, grades 9-12. The selection committee focused on creating an up-to-date environment with organized, functional workspaces that also reflected the school's high-end educational reputation.

Project:

OstermanCron furnished about 70% of the project including administrative offices and classroom chairs.
